## A NEW EXPERIENCE

Welcome to the sport of target archery in South Africa. Men, women and juniors from all sections of the community are encouraged to participate at all levels in the sport: Shooting, administration, coaching, judging, competition and representing South Africa at International events such as the Olympic games and World Championships.

## AN ANCIENT ART

The sport of archery was introduced to South Africa centuries ago, and formalised in the 1950's with the formation of the national association of archery. Since then, the South African National Archery Association (SANAA) has held over 60 national championships and participated in numerous international events.

## A NOBLE SPORT

SANAA is affiliated to a number of sporting bodies, including the international governing body FITA, the South African Sports Confederation and Olympic Committee (SASCOC) and Archery South Africa.

## A REPRESENTED SPORT

The SANAA committee consists of Executive members and Representatives from the Provincial bodies and encourages you to join the association. All you have to do is complete the membership application for on the reverse and hand it into your club or provincial secretary. If you don't yet belong to a club, send the form to the SANAA treasurer. SANAA will then provide you a list of clubs in your area through which you can formally join and experience the sport.

## BEGINNERS WELCOME

A formal training programme where you can earn the internationally recognised Feather and Arrow awards are designed for the beginner and to enrich the archery experience.
